Dear BDCHS Parents/Guardians:

Transportation often presents some difficulties for families at our school. To alleviate some of these difficulties, Brooks DeBartolo Collegiate High School is working with the Tampa Bay Area Regional Transportation Authority (TBARTA) Regional School Commute Program to provide free carpool, bike train and walking school bus matching assistance for families who are interested in sharing the commute to and from school. We are introducing this program to Brooks DeBartolo parents for the 2017-2018 school year.

Interested families who complete the School Program registration will receive a list of names and phone numbers (match list) of families from the same school as well as all participating charter schools who live in the same area and are also interested in sharing commutes to and from school. Home address information is confidential and only the closest major intersections are included on the list. Families receiving a match list are not obligated to participate and can arrange to use this program as a backup.

By registering for the school commute program, you will receive one volunteer hour. Please report this to Mrs. Dorta at idorta@bdchs.org once you have registered.

Every family should register with the program and all information is kept confidential. Information on the match list pertains only to parents from Hillsborough County Charter schools who are registered in the program. No information is provided about students. With more parents registered, there is a better chance for a match. Registering does not mean you are obligated to participate. However, from time to time, parents need back up plans for transportation and by registering, you will have another option for transportation.

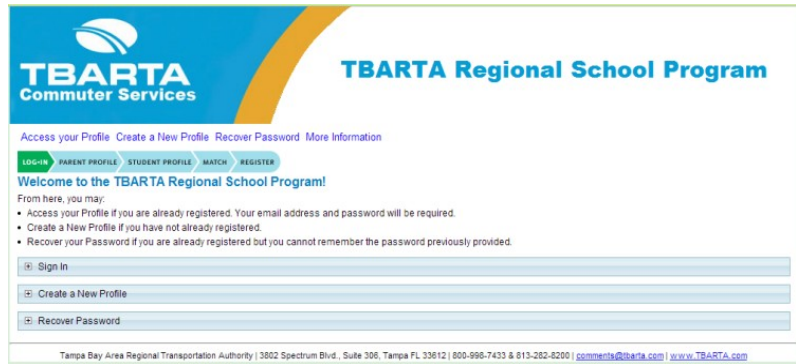
How Parents Register for the School Commute Program
