




Are You Collegiate?

Mobile Preventative Dental Services

HEALTH & SAFETY



It is very important to have preventative dental services for children. The Mobile Dental Bus provided by the Tampa Family Bealth Centers, is a full-service clinic. This is an excellent introduction to dentistry for children ages 6 months to 18 years old who can be treated on the Mobile Dental Bus for preventative services and must be accompanied by parent or guardian. If further treatment is needed a referral will be made at the time of the visit.

The Mobile Dental Bus features: On-board digital radiographs, including 2 computerized treatment areas, state of the art sterilization, and a friendly staff. There is no charge (\$80 value), however it is necessary to call and make an appointment. Participants that have a current dental home are not eligible. Walk-ins may be seen if time permits. 


