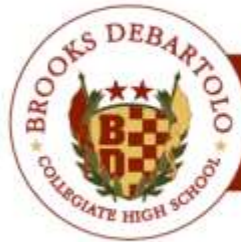

Clinic Corner

Stop the Spread of Germs!

5 Steps of Hand Hygiene

1. Wet your hands with clean, running water (warm or cold), turn off the tap and apply soap.
2. Lather your hands by rubbing them together with soap. Be sure to clean the backs of your hands, between your fingers, and under your nails
3. Scrub your hands for at least 15-30 seconds.
4. Rinse your hands well under clean, running water.
5. Dry your hands using a clean paper towel or air dry them.



Importance of Hand Washing:

- Good hand hygiene is the most effective way to stop infections from spreading.
- 80% of communicable diseases are transferred by touch.
- Proper hand washing can reduce the spread of infections by approximately 30%.
